

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF AMATEUR DART OPEN

1. NAME OF TOURNAMENT

AMATEUR DART OPEN CHAMPIONSHIPS SPORTS CARNIVAL UPM

VENUE : BILIK SEMINAR, DEWAN SERBAGUNA, SPORTS CENTRE UPM

TIME : 9.00AM TO END OF EVENT

DATE : 23 TO 24 MARCH 2019

2. GENERAL RULES OF TOURNAMENT

- 2.1. Each team is required to be at the venue of the tournament 15 minutes before the actual competition. The team will be declared as walk-over if late.
- 2.2. Manager of each team is required to submit the players form to the umpires 30 minutes before the starting of competition. Any changes to the forms are not allowed thereafter except under permission granted from the tournament committee and opponent.
- 2.4. Starting turns of the competitions will be decided through toss of a coin by umpires (Chalker).
- 2.5. Players are allowed to discuss or receive advices from any other members of own team with the exception of Chalker in between throws. Nevertheless, players are allowed to question the Chalker for the marks left and achieved.
- 2.6. Players are not allowed to perform anything that will be seen as an act to delay or slow down the competition.
- 2.7. All the games of a competition has to be carried on even though a team has won 3 out of 5 games in the grouping stage. Walk-over is not allowed with the exception of occurrence of injuries. Umpires of the competition will determine the level of the injury. Quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals will be conducted in elimination mode. Teams which are leading by 3 games will be acknowledged as the winner.
- 2.9. Manager of teams are responsible for the controlling of team members to abide the rules set by the tournament committees.

3. COUNTING OF MARKS

- 3.1. Only darts attached to the dartboard will be counted in the marks after all three of the darts has been thrown.
- 3.2. Players are not allowed to retrieve the darts attached to the dartboard till the Chalker has completed the counting of the marks.
- 3.3. The rule of 'bust' is effective under the circumstances of achieving an overhigh score and the marks are not counted in the scoreboard.
- 3.4. Players who managed to end the game in the first or second throws, second and third will be set to end the game.
- 3.5. Any mistakes have to be referred to the Chalker immediately and correction has to be done before the resuming of the competition. If there is no disagreement between both sides, the mistake will be effective and any changes to the scores are not allowed.

- 3.6. Each game has a value of one mark – Game System

4. PROHIBITIONS

- 4.1. Players are not allowed to leave the competition area with the exception of permission from umpires.
- 4.2. Slippers and shorts are not allowed. Head of teams are responsible for the abiding of suitable clothing among team members.
- 4.3. Players are not allowed to smoke, drink/take liquor or being under influence of alcohol while competing.
- 4.4. Players bringing mobile phones are required to turn off the phones or set it to 'vibrate mode' in the tournament hall.

5. FEES AND REWARDS

5.1 FEE : RM 120 / PAIR

5.2 DOUBLE OPEN

- Champion : RM1400 + Medal
First Runner-Up : RM 600 + Medal
Second Runner-Up : RM 300 + Medal
Third Runner-Up : RM 300 + Medal
Fifth-Eight Place : RM 120 + Medal

5.3 SINGLE

- Champion : RM 500 + Medal
First Runner-Up : RM 200 + Medal
Second Runner-Up : RM 100 + Medal
Third Runner-Up : RM 100 + Medal
Fifth-Eight Place : RM 50 + Medal

6. OBJECTIONS

- 6.1 Objections can be made in the time frame of 1 hour after the competition with RM200.00 deposit included. If the result of the objection is favorable to the side who has raised the objection, the deposit will be returned with a deduction of 10% as processing fees. Otherwise, the deposit will be in the possession of the tournament committee.

7. UMPIRING

- 7.1 The organizing committee with the cooperation of panel of umpires reserves the right to declare any actions or decisions to ensure the success of the tournament and any rule which has not been stated. **The decision is final.**

8. SAFETY

- 8.1 The organizing committee will not be responsible for any injuries or the loss of players' belongings for the period of the tournament.

9. FORFEIT / WALK-OVER

- 9.1 Walk-over is not allowed. Once occurred, the responsible team will be treated as walk-over for the rest of the competitions. Previous results will be cancelled automatically.
